## WINEMAKER NOTES

The dark, rich garnet color makes this Cabernet Sauvignon the king of the Horse Heaven Hills. Alder Ridge is a fantastic growing location. The prolific winds and unrelenting sun make an extremely bold Cab. But hey, we are Washingtonians; we can handle it, we love big wines. Red plum, black raspberry and sharp juniper make a rich mix seasoned with cinnamon stick and black tea leaves. I get a serious lingering violet aroma when the glass is almost empty. The bold flavors continue to amaze when tasted over a 10 hour period. I suggest opening for a while to let this wine really hit its groove. I will keep my eye on how this Cab matures over time. I am confident it will show well for years to come. How cool is our wine industry? Here's to Washington and to Cab Sauv!
