If you like New Zealand style Sauvignon Blanc, you're going to love this one. Big tropical notes like opening a can of fruit salad with melon, pineapple, mango, and peaches being mixed in with lemon lime Jell-O. It has that characteristic herbaceous grassy note of a Sauvignon Blanc with a gooseberry and flint finish. Not overly acidic but with enough to be crisp, refreshing and very easy to drink. There are a lot of crazy aromas going on here so after a long day in the yard or office try a bit of Daven Lore aromatherapy, you won't be disappointed that you did.
